Recently, actually today Mpanzu was inaugurated as a fresh member of the Dutch Parliament. His talk, his very first in his new role, will focus on inclusive entrepreneurship and business as a human right.

Mpanzu, who fled from Congo to the Netherlands, has been an active advocate for human rights, particularly against racial profiling. His own experiences with the challenges of integration have informed his approach to inclusivity in business. A landmark moment in his activism was his historic victory in court against the military police over racial profiling. This significant win underlines Mpanzu's commitment to fighting discrimination and promoting equality, especially in the realm of entrepreneurship.

This victory, combined with his legal training and experiences, shapes Mpanzu's perspective on the intersection of entrepreneurship and human rights. He emphasizes the role of inclusive practices and policies in fostering a fair and just business environment. His speech at the DNNL event is expected to offer deep insights into how entrepreneurship, when grounded in principles of human rights and inclusivity, can contribute to societal change and equity.
